RECRUITMENT TO THE POST OF CONSTABLES IN WEST BENGAL POLICE - 2024 ADVT. No. WBPRB/NOTICE - 2024/13 (CONS._WBP_24)

COMMENCEMENT OF SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATION: 07.03.2024 (from 00:01 hrs.) LAST DATE OF RECEIPT OF ONLINE APPLICATION: 05.04.2024 (till 23:59 hrs.). Editing Window: -08.04.2024 to 14.04.2024

- **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:** The applicant must have passed **Madhyamik Examination** from the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education or its equivalent.
- **AGE** (As on 01/01/2024): 18-30 Years (Relaxation of age limit for SC/ST − 5 Years, OBC − 3 Years, Third Gender/Transgender persons 3 Years, Civic Volunteers / Village Police Volunteers. 5 Years). The upper age limit is also relaxable for NVF/Home Guards Personnel serving in West Bengal Police only as per existing Government Rules.

LANGUAGE: - The applicant must be able to read, write and speak Bengali language provided that the provision will not be applicable to the persons who are permanent residents of hill sub-divisions of Darjeeling and Kalimpong Districts.

Note:-

- The category to which a Third Gender persons is to be accommodated will be intimated in due course.
- Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) category candidates of OTHER States will be treated as General (Un-reserved) category candidates.
- The Ex-servicemen and NVF/Home Guards personnel (serving in WBP only), if shortlisted for Interview, have to produce relevant documents regarding service rendered by them, in original, in support of their claim for Age Relaxation at the time of verification during Interview.
- Applicants already employed in any Government Organization shall produce No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the Head of the Office/Disciplinary authority during interview, if shortlisted for the same.

- Applicants belonging to the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe (of West Bengal only) shall only pay the processing fees of Rs. 20/- (Rupees Twenty) as they are exempted from paying any application fees. However, shortlisted candidates are required to produce their SC/ST certificates issued by the competent authority at the time of verification on the date of Interview failing which their candidature shall abinitio be considered void.
- No exemption of fees is available to the SC/ST candidates of OTHER States.
- Neither any claim for refund of the fee will be entertained nor will it be reassigned for any other examination under any circumstances whatsoever.
- Applications not accompanied with the requisite application fees and/or processing fees shall be rejected summarily.

*** METHOD OF RECRUITMENT:**

The posts of Constable in West Bengal Police shall be filled up on the basis of Written Examination followed by Physical Measurement Test (PMT), Physical Efficiency Test (PET) and Interview to be conducted by the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board.

A. FINAL WRITTEN EXAMINATION (Full Marks : 85, Total time : 1 hr.) :- Applicants provisionally considered eligible will be called for the Written Examination which will be OMR based and in MCQ pattern. The duration of the Written Examination will be of 1(one) hour. There would be 85 objective type questions having multiple choice (four choices) of answers carrying 01 (one) mark each. The marks obtained in the Written Examination will be taken into account while preparing the merit list for selection. Question paper will be set in two languages (Bengali & Nepali). Questions of the Written Examination shall be from the following subjects:-

(A) General Awareness and General Knowledge
(B) English
(C) Elementary Mathematics (Madhyamik standard)
(D) Reasoning and Logical Analysis
(D) Reasoning and Logical Analysis

For each incorrect answer, there will be negative marking of $\frac{1}{4}$ th of the total marks allocated to the question.

- **B. PHYSICAL MEASUREMENT TEST (PMT) :-** A limited number of candidates will be shortlisted on the basis of marks obtained in the Written Examination for Physical Measurement Test (PMT) which will be qualifying in nature. Physical standards (height, weight) of the candidates as given above will be tested by using Electronic Machines. **The chest measurement (only for Male candidates) will be taken by using measuring tape.**
- **C. PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST (PET) :-** Candidates who qualify in PMT will be allowed to take part in PET as given under. PET is also qualifying in nature.

PMT & PET are qualifying in nature.

☐. INTERVIEW : (Full Marks : 15) : -

All the candidates qualified in Physical Efficiency Test (PET) will be called for Interview. The procedure, date, time and venue of Interview will be decided by West Bengal Police Recruitment Board. In the Interview, the general awareness and suitability of the candidates for public service will be tested. Candidates' ability to speak, read and write in Bengali/Nepali language will be tested specifically during the Interview.

On the basis of the marks obtained in the Written Examination and the Interview, a merit list of the provisionally selected candidates will be prepared by the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board.

- **Note:-**If 02 (two) or more candidates secure the same total marks, their seniority in the final merit/selection list will be decided upon comparing the marks obtained by the candidates in the Written Examination. The one who secures higher marks in the Written Examination will precede in the Merit List. If the marks secured in the Written Examination are also the same then seniority will be determined by their age. The one, older in age will find precedence in the Merit List. In case of same Date of Birth the principle of determining seniority will be decided by the Board.
- *** HOW TO APPLY : -** Applicants will be able to submit their application using the websites of West Bengal Police Recruitment Board (*https://prb.wb.gov.in*); West Bengal Police (*wbpolice.gov.in*).

Payment of Application and/or Processing Fees shall be made through payment gateway by using Debit Cards/Credit Cards/Net-Banking of any Bank. Fees can also be paid through different e-wallets and UPI App.

☆ OTHER INSTRUCTIONS:-

- ◆ Issuance of Admit Card for Preliminary Written Test or any latter stage is subject to acceptance of candidature on fulfilling the eligibility criteria and proper submission of application form. Hence, getting SMS on final submission of Application Form doesn't warrant issuance of any Admit Card/Call Letter to the applicants for Preliminary Written Test or further stages.
- ◆ The photograph, biometric data with iris of a candidate may be captured at different stages of recruitment process. The photograph, biometric and/or iris of the candidate appeared in different stages will be matched with that of captured in earlier stages. In case of any mismatch of face, biometric and/or iris candidature shall be rejected summarily. No cosmetic surgery in between, unless scarred by grievous injury which must be promptly conveyed with the copies of documents to the **WBPRB at wbprb10@gmail.com** mentioning the Subject, Application Serial Number with the name of Recruitment Drive.
- Each applicant should submit ONE application form only. Application of those who submit more than one application form will be rejected summarily and the amount of application and/or processing fees will be forfeited.

- ◆ Application Forms shall be rejected in case the signature of the applicant is uploaded/rendered in block letters/unintelligible/does not match with the name of the candidate.
- ◆ Candidates dissatisfied with their Physical Measurement Test (PMT) during field test may appeal in writing before the Chairperson, of the Selection Board/Committee on the same day of their tests. No appeal in this regard will be entertained in future
- ◆ The height of a candidate may be re-measured at any stage including at the Interview at the discretion of the Board and the decision of the Board shall be final and binding on the candidates.
- The Mobile No. and e-mail ID of the applicants are being taken for communication by the Board for future intimation with regard to the recruitment process and nothing else. The Board, under no circumstances, will request or advise the applicant for any further personal information and/or additional fees and/or payment of any kind of fee to any official connected and/or not connected with the Board. Candidates may report such occurrence, if any to the Member, West Bengal Police Recruitment Board, along with due evidence (documentary/electronic) and also communications other than change of caste/category to be sent to WBPRB (wbprb10@gmail.com) mentioning the subject of grievance or request clearly.

Photograph and Signature Scan & Upload Instructions

Applicants are required to upload their recent (not more than 3 months old) passport size coloured photograph and scanned copy of full signature in .jpg format covering the entire space provided for the same. The size of the photograph file must be within 10 kb - 50 kb. In case of mismatch of signature with the name, the application form is liable to be rejected.

Photograph of the candidate should satisfy the following primary requirements:

- O Recent photo (not more than 3 months old) facing forward and looking straight into the camera.
- O Must be on white background.
- O Without anything covering the face.
- O In clear contrast to the background.
- O Without a head covering.
- O With eyes open, visible and free from reflection or glare from glasses.
- O With eyes not covered by sunglasses, tinted glasses, glass frames or lock of hair.
- O Without any 'red eye' and without any shadow in the picture.
- O With a normal expression.

Signature of the candidate must contain the full name and surname of the candidate as entered by him/her in the application form and the signature shall be in long hand. **The size of signature file must be within 5 kb - 20 kb.**

- The image dimension for photograph and signature should be 177 px h \times 138 px w (4.5 cm height \times 3.5 cm width) and 63 px h \times 350 px w (1.7 cm height \times 9.2 cm width) respectively.
- Applicants are advised not to upload images of other objects in place of photograph and signature. Photographs cropped from 'groupies' or 'selfies' shall also be disallowed during the scrutiny.
- On successful submission of the application, the applicants will get an SMS to their registered mobile number. Each applicant is required to have an individual mobile number and e-mail Id. Sharing of mobile number between applicants is not permitted. The Mobile Number and Email Id. should remain unaltered till the completion of entire process of the recruitment because the candidates will get OTP at his/her mobile number and at his/her e-mail id during various stages of the recruitment process. The Board does not owe any responsibility for failure in delivery of SMS or e-mail due to change in Mobile Number/e-mail Id. or other technical reason. The applicants are advised to take a print out of his/her application form, preserve it safely and mention the Application Sl. No. for all future communications if required with the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board be it in verbal or written form.

☆ EDITING WINDOW:-

An editing window for 07 (seven) days will be given to the applicants who want to edit/rectify their personal information already submitted in their Application Form. The period of this **editing window will be available from 08.04.2024 to 14.04.2024**. To edit the personal information, the applicant will have to provide their (i) Application Sl. No. or Registered Mobile Number (ii) Date of Birth (DOB) as entered in the Application. On providing these information, the applicant will get an OTP to their Mobile Number. On successful verification of OTP the applicant will be allowed to edit their information (except permanent State, Mobile Number & E-mail Id.). Applicants can change their category but change from non-paying category (SC & ST) to paying category (UR, EWS, OBC-A & OBC-B) [Application Fees] shall not be allowed.

After editing all the details, the applicant has to submit the edited application otherwise no change will be reflected in the main data. Applicants will also be able to download the modified application pdf only after submission of the edited application or else the previous application pdf will be available.

Request for change/correction in the personal details (except category) shall not be entertained under any circumstances after the last date of editing window. The West Bengal Police Recruitment Board will not be responsible for any consequences arising out of non-acceptance of any correction/addition/deletion in any particular field in application form whatever the reason may be. However, if a candidate procures caste certificate after editing window is closed and wants to change his/her category, the candidates must submit the petitions with relevant documents at changing.caste.category.ews.only@gmail.com mentioning the subject properly with Application Sl. No. and Recruitment Drive e.g.
